- Paper Portfolio at least 19 x 25
- Tackle Box, Drawing Box, or ArtBin for carrying drawing supplies
- Bulldog Clips #4, at least 4 clips
- 18 x 24 Strathmore 400 Series Drawing, Medium Surface, 24 sheets, 80lbs
- 18 x 24 smooth Bristol Board pad
- Vine or willow charcoal, soft
- 1 pad of 18" x 24" newsprint
- Compressed charcoal sticks and/or Black Conte Crayons
- Blending stump (or Tortillon)
- Chamois
- Graphite pencils H, HB, 2B, 4B, 6B (reputable brands Staedtler Mars Lumograph, Faber Castell 9000 Pencils, or Derwent Graphic Pencils)
- Ebony pencils
- Conte Crayon, 2 White HB
- Masking Tape
- Sandpaper Sharpening Pad
- Workable fixative
- Pencil Sharpener
- Erasers: one kneaded, one vinyl or white plastic

NEW POLICY RE: CLASS SUPPLIES

To ease confusion for beginning artists, all materials will be provided for the first two class meetings of all adult, **Beginner-level classes**. These classes will be noted in the class description with "Some supplies included." Students in beginner-level classes will be given guidance during their first class meeting on which supplies to purchase for the remainder of the season. Adult students in **Intermediate- or Advanced-level classes**, or any class without the notation listed above, are expected to purchase all supplies on their class supply list and bring those supplies to the first class meeting.

Some workshops require **unconventional materials** (non-art materials, household objects, etc.). Most items can be found easily; however, if you have any difficulty obtaining these materials, do contact the School Office who may be able to recommend an alternative option.
